1	PURPOSE	
	The purpose of the International Jukskei Federation Development Committee	
	(hereinafter referred to as IJFDC) is the coordination and management of all	
	development issues and to manage development to the benefit of International	
	Jukskei.	
2	REACH OF THE IJFDC	
2.1	IJFDC is a full-fledged sub-committee of the Exco of the IJF and is subject to the Statute of IJF. Refer IJF Constitution Clause 11.12.	
2.2	IJFDC manages:	
	a) All matters relating to development at the International level.	
,	b) Affiliated Countries and countries under development are members of IJFDC.	
	c) See categories of membership under Article 10 of the IJF Constitution .	
3	FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES	
3.1	The functions and responsibilities of the Development are as follows:	
3.2	Is responsible:	
	 a) for the standardization of development on an international level across all Jukskei playing countries. 	
	b) to research to improve development within the reach of the IJF in line with	
	other sports codes.	
3.3	IJFDC will perform the following functions in the management of Jukskei as sport:	
	a) is responsible for coordinating the development of all international players	
	b) manages all matters relating to the functions of IJF development (eg recruitment, which include the application of membership, development	
	opportunities and initiatives);	
	c) conducts research on development and recruitment methods of sports and	
	implements them in Jukskei;	
	d) reports annually to the IJF General Meeting	
4	STRUCTURE	
4.1	The structure of the IJFD is defined in the Constitution of the IJF . See Clause	
	11.22.5 b)	
4.2	The responsibilities of members of the IJFDC are defined in Article 3 of this Regulation.	
4.3	The Director, Development is responsible for allocating specific tasks to members	
	of the IJF and may co-opt additional specialists for specific tasks.	
5	REQUESTS FOR DEVELOPMENT	
5.1	Requests for development etc., must be submitted to the Secretariat of the UF	
5.1.1	The request is then directed to IJFA and IJFD	
5.1.2	IJFA will appoint facilitators and trainers to present the development.	

6	REPORTING	
6.1	All reports and/or requests from the Committee to countries will be sent through the Secretary to the Director of Administration for distribution.	
6.2	Other correspondence, such as internal correspondence between Committee members, should go through the Secretariat.
